

Post Supports Operation MOMMA Drop!

Our Blue Star Mothers Chapter, Cereal City MOMMAS, was contacted by the 110th Wing's Airman & Family Readiness Program, asking if they could provide items to support 200 Servicemembers who would be in Quarantine during the Holidays. They

were in need of items to keep them occupied during the 14 days they would be housed at Alpena

CRTC (Combat Readiness Training Center), MI ANG. As a part of their upcoming deployments, these servicemembers were required to remain in place to ensure they don't carry the Coronavirus along with them.

After deciding the Cereal City MOMMAS could support this mission, they reached out to our Post for delivery assistance. At the time, the destination was unknown, except where there was a need to know. Knowing the location is about a 5 hour drive from Battle Creek, we came up with the idea of inviting other Michigan Posts to participate in transporting these needed items to the deploying servicemembers...a relay as such. After studying maps, Posts were selected based on their location along the route to Alpena CRTC. Contact was made with each Post, along with details of rendezvous locations and times. Each Post that was contacted was MORE than willing to lend a hand with this VERY worthwhile mission!

On Tuesday, 15 Dec 2020, **Operation MOMMA Drop** commenced at 12:00 Noon! The first leg of the trip brought Commander, Brian Mohlman, and 2nd Vice -Commander, Samuel Gray, to a rest area along US-127 just North of Clare, MI. There, they met with Sanford Post 443 Member, Mark Kloha, where they transferred the cargo, and handed off the packet of delivery instructions.

Mark Kloha proceeded North to Grayling, where he met up with Post 106 Adjutant, Brenda Bess. Again, the cargo was transferred, delivery instructions were handed off, and Brenda and her husband finished the drive to Alpena Post 65, where they were met by Post 65 Adjutant, Ryan Wright. Once the cargo arrived, Ryan contacted Alpena CRTC's First Sergeant, MSgt Andy White, to arrange for final pick-up at the Post. The entire Operation took just
